 - o solutions that enable us to proactively monitor, manage and respond to staff fatigue, promoting well-being and maintaining optimal performance levels.

- Health and Safety in infrastructure projects
 - o solutions that reduce health and safety risks in infrastructure projects such as demolition and construction logistics.
 - o communication solutions that enable efficient and effective exchange of real-time information in infrastructure project management.
- Robotic and autonomous solutions
 - innovative use of robotic and autonomous technologies that reduce manual handling and increase safety.
- Staff well-being
 - technologies that enable DSE assessment of colleagues working at their computers, recognizing interventions needed to ensure safety of their work with computer and desk
 - technologies or solutions that help us proactively identify mental health concerns, fatigue etc. and support our staffs in addressing them.


About Heathrow Lift Off

Health & Safety Platform

Onwave showcased their OWL portal that can enhance Health, Safety and Wellbeing and productivity for onsite works using geofencing technologies alongside wearable devices. Initial trial has been proven successful in Southern Runway Project. Planning is going on for wider application for the technology in Heathrow construction programmes.



Automatic Food Waste Processing

Vuala proposed their automatic food waste separation solution that can optimise food waste handling processes and improve recycling rate. Initial trial is scheduled to be run from Jan 2025 in our Terminal 5 staff canteen with potential scope to scale up.



Sustainable Solutions

Powerquad presented their capabilities in sustainable portable power supply to a panel including our major infrastructure partners. Their solution is being trial by Ferrovial now that looks at replacing glim lamps using batteries by the ones with customised rechargeable batteries.

Rype Office showcased their furniture remanufacturing and auditing capabilities that can add great value in our sustainability agenda. They've supported our delivery partner Volkerfitzpatrick in delivering great carbon saving in a furniture storage repurposing project. They are currently onboarding as Heathrow supplier.

Inclusive Infrastructure Design

Child Graddon Lewis and Mima Group presented their proposals in inclusive infrastructure design that looks at how we can design our space with more consideration of inclusiveness. Both SMEs have been onboarded to our Accessibility and Inclusion Framework as approved Heathrow suppliers.
