Delivering our extraordinary night care already costs the Hospice **£343,000 a year**. And, as the numbers of patients who need us grows, so do our costs. Looking after a patient for an hour costs **£37.49** and an entire night of a nurse's expert care costs **£412**. Therefore, however much you can raise will truly help us to be there as that number grows.
