



Skills Bootcamps

- Skills Bootcamps seek to address skills gaps to boost the regional and UK economy.
 - o usually delivered at Levels 3-5, aligned to **IFATE**.
- Developed with employers, the training is delivered up to 16 weeks, with a 60 GLH minimum*.
- Wrap-around support to aid progression.
- Approved <u>framework</u> or directly procured training providers to deliver Skills Bootcamps on our behalf, either online, face-to-face or via a hybrid model











Employers

Funded by UK Government

- Skills Bootcamps can be used as an excellent recruitment tool to fill current and future vacancies.
- Where there are multiple skills shortage vacancies, training providers may be able to tailor a course specific to their needs.
- For employers wishing to upskill their existing workforce, there is an employer contribution.
 - 10% for SME, or 30% for larger employers.









Eligibility

Funded by UK Government

- Residents aged 19* and over are eligible:
 - You can be in full-time or part-time employment, selfemployed, unemployed, or returning to work after a break.
- Learners who are applying independently can access the Skills Bootcamps fully funded (there may be a contribution requirement from the employer):
 - If you are unemployed, you will be offered a guaranteed interview with an employer at the end of your course.
- All Skills Bootcamps learners are offered support upon completion of their course to progress within their chosen field:
 - o securing a new job, responsibilities or work for learners.


